MEMORANDUM FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE USUHS BRIGADE

SUBJECT: Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) / Driving Under the
Influence (DUI)

Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) or Driving Under the Influence (DUI) or any lesser alcohol-related offense constitute illegal conduct and are incompatible with the maintenance of high standards of performance, military discipline, and readiness. DWI and DUI offenses pose a serious threat to the health and welfare of the USUHS community. Individuals involved in situations of this nature will immediately be made aware, via their direct chain of command, of the serious breach of conduct it portrays.

Current regulations require immediate referral to the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Program Coordinator upon apprehension for DWI or DUI. Additionally, disciplinary action under the UCMJ may result.

All levels of leadership will take aggressive action to prevent alcohol impaired driving. Risk factors for DWI or DUI, alternative options, and possible consequences will be addressed and reinforced during in-processing, periodic command information classes, and prior to holiday periods.
