

Recruitment, retention and relocation allowances may cause pay to exceed Total Pay limitations except for level I of the Executive Schedule.
4. Any pay, including allowances, is creditable towards retirement for employees covered under TIAA-CREF, Fidelity, or other retirement system not established under 5 U.S.C.
5. The salary schedules shown above are exclusive of lump-sum performance awards.
