The Adult Examination is to be given when the adult module is given alone, without the child and infant module. There are 20 questions; the passing score is 84% with 17 or more questions being correct. Students scoring less than 84% or more than 3 incorrect answers (17 correct answers) require remediation and a retest for completion.

The Adult and Child Examination is to be given when the child module is given with the adult module or if it is given alone (when the student has already completed an adult CPR and AED course.) Because adult CPR and AED skills are still an integral part of learning to use an AED on a child, the Heartsaver AED course will test the cognitive knowledge on this subject, even if the skills are not examined or practiced. There are 29 questions; the passing score is 84% with 25 or more questions being correct. Students scoring less than 84% or more than 4 incorrect answers (25 correct answers) require remediation and a retest for completion.

Some courses may combine both modules along with infant CPR. In these courses, there are 33 questions; the passing score is 84% with 28 or more questions being correct. Students scoring less than 84% or more than 5 incorrect answers (28 correct answers) require remediation and a retest for completion.
