UNIVERSITY FACULTY MEMBER RECEIVES DEPARTMENT PROMOTION

BETHESDA, Md. – Sonia Q. Doi, M.D., Ph.D., has been promoted to research associate professor at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. Doctor Doi has been on the USU faculty since 1994 and currently serves as the director of the Nephrology Research Laboratory, Division of Nephrology, in the university's Department of Medicine. Her teaching responsibilities include lectures for the university's Molecular and Cell Biology Program, and training fellows and graduate students in basic research.

Doctor Doi received her medical degree from the University of São Paulo (Brazil) School of Medicine in 1976 and her Ph.D. from the University of São Paulo School of Pharmaceutical Sciences in 2000.
